Brazil accounts for only 27% of solar capacity that is currently operating or under construction in Latin America, but 65% of the capacity in the pre-construction phase, and so is home ...

In 2024, Brazil ranked among the top five largest solar photovoltaic markets globally. In terms of installed capacity, the country was among the top 10 worldwide.

In Brazil, solar photovoltaic dominates the distributed generation sector, representing 99% of the country's total distributed generation capacity. Small hydroelectric and wind account for ...

In the last five years, Brazil has increased its solar photovoltaic energy generating capacity by more than 6-fold. In 2020, the country's installed solar PV capacity stood at 8.5 gigawatts.
