In 2012, the Vatican announced it was cutting in half the hours of transmission from the site, not because of health concerns but because of cost-saving technological advances in internet ...

Vatican City is set to become the eighth country in the world to generate 100 per cent of its electricity from renewable energy after Pope Francis announced plans to build a solar plant.

One of the most notable solar projects in Vatican City is the solar roof of the Paul VI Audience Hall. The photovoltaic panels installed here generate approximately 300,000 kilowatt-hours of energy annually.

The world's smallest country just made a big move: Vatican City is now powered entirely by solar energy, setting an example for global climate action.

The Vatican is now completely powered by a farm that sports solar panels to help shade-tolerant crops thrive. This new coupling of solar and agriculture is growing fast.

A solar panel system is being built on the 424 hectares of extraterritorial land in Ponte Galeria, which within a year will make the Holy See the first zero-emission state in the world.

By installing solar panels in our 42 parish churches, the diocese will try to avoid 191 metric tons of carbon dioxide emissions over the next 25 years through the generation of solar...

It asks the Church, and the world, to imagine a future where the power that lights the Vatican's basilicas comes not from fossil fuels, but from the sun that shines on its fields.

This ambitious project, which has received approval from the Italian government, aims to generate sufficient electricity to fulfill the energy needs of Vatican City, aligning with Pope Francis' ...
