Uzbekistan's President Shavkat Mirziyoyev has launched the construction of 21 new energy and infrastructure facilities as part of the country's efforts to transition to sustainable energy.

New facilities - 42 new generation, storage and production capacities and other energy infrastructure worth \$11 billion, are a part of the major strategy being implemented in our country, ...

The Nur Bukhara solar and battery storage project will generate electricity for over 55,000 homes. It will also help avoid approximately 367,000 tons of CO2 emissions annually.

Of the 15 planned projects, two are already operational and supplying electricity, while six are under active construction with a target completion date of 2025.

The construction of the first phase of Artemisya - comprising 100 megawatts / 200 megawatt-hours of storage and the first 100-megawatt wind tranche - was launched following the ...
