Which countries have financed solar projects in Palau?

installed at the Capitol Complex in 2008.¹³ Subsidized private financing of grid-connected solar through the National Development Bank of Palau (NDBP), initiated in 2010, has increased solar uptake in Palau.¹³ Several renewable energy projects have been funded by Europe, Japan, and Taiwan, among others.

Does Palau have a mobile network?

Currently, Palau has one primary mobile operator, the Palau National Communications Corporation (PNCC), which operates the PalauCel mobile network Fandom. PNCC's network offers 2G/3G coverage nationwide and 4G LTE service in the main population centers of Koror and Airai Fandom.

Does Palau have satellite internet?

Given Palau's remote location and scattered islands, satellite internet has always played a role in connectivity - and it continues to do so even as fiber-optic cables dominate international traffic.

How much solar energy does Palau have?

Palau currently boasts 600 kilowatts(kW) of grid-connected solar energy, as compared to a daily peak demand of 9-10 MW.⁸ The first 6.5-kW grid-connected solar project on the Public Works Department building was funded by Japan in 2008.
